

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

RE ISLA VISTA FEST 2020 dated February 28, 2020

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between the Isla Vista Community Services District (“CSD”) and the Regents of the University of California on behalf of the Santa Barbara campus (“UCSB”) with respect to the CSD’s hosting of the Isla Vista Fest 2020.

UCSB is pleased to support the CSD in the CSD’s 2020 Deltopia weekend event, currently known as Isla Vista Fest. The purpose of this memorandum is to memorialize agreements and understandings between UCSB and the CSD as it relates to the CSD’s Isla Vista Fest.

- Nothing in this MOU is intended to create a partnership or joint venture between the parties.
- The CSD is the host of Isla Vista Fest which is scheduled to take place on Saturday, April 4, 2020 from Noon-6pm in Anisq’Oyo Park.
- The CSD is obtaining all necessary permits and insurance required to host the Isla Vista Fest.
- Isla Vista Fest is intended to be an alternative option for community area residents in lieu of the non-sanctioned street party commonly known as Deltopia.
- Isla Vista Fest will be open to the community as long as they are 18 year old or over or have a UCSB student identification.
- The CSD has contracted with Lucidity which will provide sound equipment, fencing, signage, stage décor, and coordinate a medical tent.
- The capacity of the event will be approximately 2,000 people over the course of the day and the CSD will coordinate with the Santa Barbara County Fire Marshal to obtain requisite approval for this number in the park. The CSD will be responsible for ensuring that capacity within the fencing of the event space does not exceed the number of occupants approved by the Santa Barbara County Fire Marshal.
- The CSD will be responsible for ensuring security at the event including installation of fencing and coordination with the Santa Barbara Sheriff’s Office.
- The CSD has met with the Sheriff’s Office which has agreed to staff the event with six (6) deputies.
- The CSD will ensure that there are sufficient restrooms available to attendees.
- Alcohol will not be provided or allowed at Isla Vista Fest.
- The UCSB Dean of Students Office will assist with coordination of the registration of attendees and will request liability waivers from registered attendees.
- The UCSB Dean of Students Office will coordinate the food vendors for the event and will provide free food to registered attendees.
- The UCSB Dean of Students Office will coordinate games and a rock wall for the event.
- UCSB is not a co-sponsor of Isla Vista Fest. However, UCSB will provide a donation of \$30,000 to the CSD in support of the CSD’s event.
- The CSD accepts full responsibility and liability for Isla Vista Fest 2020. CSD agrees to indemnify, defend and hold UCSB harmless against any loss, damage or claim of any kind arising out of the Isla Vista Fest 2020 (including reasonable attorneys’ fees).
