



## GOLETA WATER DISTRICT

The Goleta Water District is changing from at-large elections, where all voters in the District elect five people to represent the entire District, to district-based elections, where voters in a smaller area elect one person to represent that area. This means we'll be drawing five separate voting districts within our boundaries, to go into effect with the November 2022 election.

## HOW TO GET INVOLVED

GWD will be holding hearings to receive public input on where district lines should be drawn. At these meetings you can share feedback and suggestions for new district lines

You can also participate remotely through submitting public comments, community of interest surveys and mapping tools. Communities of Interest surveys will help guide GWD in finding what residents see as important connections shared between others in the Goleta Valley.
